# Liechtenstein ISU-Development-Figure-Skating-Camp for small nations and federations 2026

### Dear friends of figure skating in small nations, and smaller federations in Europe

We are happy to announce that the third "Liechtenstein ISU-Development-Figure-Skating-Camp for small nations and federations 2026" will take place, supported by the ISU Development Program.

As part of the ISU Development Program, we are pleased to invite your federation to participate in our figure skating training camp. The camp will take place from Sunday, July 26 (with arrival on Saturday, July 25) to Saturday, August 1, 2026 (departure on Sunday, August 2), in Flims, Switzerland. This event is made possible through the generous financial support of the ISU to foster young talents and support their development in figure skating. It also aims to help the small nations community develop ice skating in their countries.

The ISU Development Project will take place as a stand-alone camp during the international figure skating training camp "Super Summer Camp Flims, which runs over a period of five weeks from July 6 to August 8, 2026. ## Event Details:

- **Arrival:** Saturday, July 25, 2026
- **Camp duration:** From Sunday morning, July 26 to Saturday evening, August 1, 2026
- **Departure:** Sunday, August 2, 2026
- **Location:** Sportzentrum Prau la Selva, Via Prau la Selva 6, 7018 Flims Waldhaus, Switzerland (60 km from Liechtenstein) <https://sportzentrum-flims.ch>
- **Target group:** Young athletes at the Novice and Junior levels, preferably accompanied by their coaches, from small European nations and smaller skating federations, are invited to participate. Based on last year's participant feedback, there will be more differentiated training options for Novice skaters, including provisions for lower levels.
- **Maximum participants:** 35 (about 23 novices and 12 juniors), and 8 coaches, with priority given to small countries, small nations, and neighboring countries.
- **Costs for participants:** CHF 300 participation fee plus CHF 330 for accommodation, **total CHF 630 for the camp and accommodation**, including breakfast, and one meal for dinner. These moderate prices are made possible thanks to ISU Development support!
- **Costs for accompanying coaches:** CHF 150 participation plus CHF 330 for accommodation, **total CHF 480 for the camp and accommodation**, including breakfast, and one meal for dinner.
- **Ice times for training:** Additional patches on request are possible to book as long as there are free places. Additional ice fees have to be paid.
- **Simultaneous training for accompanying coaches**
- **Focus** on jumps, while also considering skating skills and rotations.
- **Overview presentations on GOE and Components**, followed by on-ice feedback
- **Overview presentation on Levels**, followed by on-ice Level Control
- **Accommodation in one house** with opportunities to build community.
- **Safeguarding and Code of Conduct** will be clearly communicated, implemented, and signed.
- **Initiation of the promotion of figure skating development** in small nations and federations through regular exchange, especially through a **meeting of representatives from the participating federations**, coaches, and a representative of the Development Camp, with the option for online participation, on Wednesday July 29, 2026,

Athletes, coaches, and officials will be responsible for all travel expenses.

## **Goals of the Training Camp:**

The training camp aims to comprehensively support young talents at the Novice and Junior levels. It provides them with opportunities to improve their technical skills and learn from a highly qualified coaching team.

The third Liechtenstein Development Camp builds on the positive feedback from the past two years regarding content, coaching team, organization, and accommodation. The focus of this camp is on jumps, while also considering skating skills and rotations. Technical highlights include the further development of spins with targeted training on levels, clean positions, high-quality entries and exits, harness training, edge work, and speed.

Participants targeted are Basic Novice to Juniors from small nations and federations, as well as from neighboring countries of Liechtenstein. Groups of participants along with their coaches are preferred to ensure the sustainability of the training, taking into account that participants from these federations are often still in basic development..

Finally, the camp is an opportunity for small nations and federations to discuss the issues they face, explore ways to address them, and build connections with participants from similarly sized federations. We will continue the successful format of a meeting among representatives of the participating federations, coaches, and a Development Camp representative, with an option for online participation.

## **Coaching Team:**

The excellent coaching team, focusing on jumps, while also considering skating skills and rotations, includes technical specialists Elena Romanova, Marius Negrea, Jacqueline Kiefer, Julia Sheiko, and Myriam Lorient (the latter two also responsible for level control), as well as harness coach Oscar Peter. Daily dance classes and choreography will be led by Sabrina Messmer (Off-Ice Dance Expert and Choreographer), while fitness sessions will be conducted by Mikhail Semenov (Acrobatics and Fitness Expert) as part of the sports management team.

Additionally, presentations by experts Leanna Caron and Myriam Lorient on GOE and levels will be offered, which will also include feedback on the ice for level control and the latest guidelines. Running programs with feedback on the ice are part of the weekly schedule.

## Participants younger than 16 years

- Participants under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult, confirmed by a parent's signature. This accompanying person can be their coach or another trusted individual.

- We will do our best to accommodate accompanying persons, coaches, or parents at wellnessHostel3000 in Laax (see accommodation details below). However, they are personally responsible for arranging and covering the costs of their own accommodation.

- We warmly welcome small groups of younger participants to be accompanied by a parent they know and trust.
- For participants between the ages of 8 and 16 who are not accompanied by an adult, we offer supervised accommodation at wellnessHostel3000 in Laax (see accommodation details below). Children under the age of 14 must have parents or guardians who can pick them up within a few hours in case of emergencies. The young participants will be supervised by Marco Schmellentin, Werner Künzler, Cornelia or Patrik Kaiser. They will be on-site, available to help, and will also provide short van transfers to the ice rink. Please note: sufficient knowledge of English is required.  
When registering, you can indicate if you would like supervision at wellnessHostel. A separate declaration is needed for this.  
*The supervisors Marco Schmellentin, Werner Künzler, Cornelia and Patrik Kaiser are board members of the Liechtenstein Federation. They are required to complete the Safeguarding Basics course and must sign a Code of Conduct, which will be submitted to the ISU Development Commission.*
- Accident and health insurance are the responsibility of the participants.

## **Code of Conduct**

The Code of Conduct, as an additional tool to implement safeguarding, is part of the registration process. Participating skaters, coaches, and accompanying persons from the federations must confirm that they have read and understood the Code of Conduct at the time of registration. The designated on-site officials will also serve as contact persons should a violation of the Code of Conduct be detected and reported. A defined process is in place for reporting and handling violations.

## Accommodation

We aim to accommodate as many participants as possible – especially accompanying coaches, but also accompanying parents – at **wellnessHostel3000** in Laax. The hostel is just a few minutes by car from the ice rink. A swimming pool and a fitness room are available at this youth hostel. The spa is clothing-free, accessible from age 14, and available at a special price of CHF 13 instead of CHF 37. Massage options are also available and can be booked independently starting two weeks before the appointment at: <https://shop.auagrava.ch/reservations/category/122/>.

There are different room sizes, ranging from double to four-bed rooms. We do our best when assigning rooms, but flexibility is necessary in a youth hostel.

A shuttle service is organized, and there are also public bus connections available. The accommodation price includes breakfast and dinner. For individual lunches, we recommend the restaurant by the ice rink and the hostel restaurant.



Please note that, in general, accompanying persons are responsible for arranging and covering their own accommodation.
